Practice for the school musical is underway! Please check the website here <https://oakhillsmusical.outerim.com/> for any updates, music, and videos.

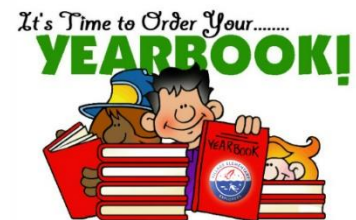


Spelling Bee

HOW SICK IS TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

FLU SEASON IS HERE, WHICH MEANS GERMS ARE SNEEZING THEIR WAY INTO SCHOOLS



Keep me home:

- Temperature higher than 100 degrees
- Sore throat, cold and persistent cough
- Vomiting (more than two times in 24 hours)
- Diarrhea
- Severe or long-lasting abdominal pain
 - Rash with fever
 - Strep throat
 - Head lice before first treatment
- Illness prevents me from participating comfortably in activities
- Illness results in a greater need for care than school staff can provide.



Send me to school:

- Runny nose or occasional cough, but no other symptoms
- No fever, without fever-reducing medicine in 24 hours
- Sore throat with no other symptoms
- Strep throat after 12 hours of treatment
- No vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours


