

### HOW SICK IS TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

FLU SEASON IS HERE WHICH MEANS GERMS ARE SNEEZING THEIR WAY INTO SCHOOLS



### Keep me home:

- Temperature higher than 100 degrees
- Sore throat, cold and persistent
- Vomiting (more than two times in 24 hours)
- Diarrhea
- Severe or long-lasting abdominal pain
  - Rash with fever
  - Strep throat
  - Head lice before first treatment
    - Illness prevents me from participating comfortably in activities
  - Illness results in a greater need for care than school staff can provide.

Davis School District Nursing Services guidelines, Davis County Health Department and American Academy of Pediatrics



#### Send me to school:

- Runny nose or occasional cough, but no other symptoms
- No fever, without fever-reducing medicine in 24 hours
- Sore throat with no other symptoms
- Strep throat after 12 hours of treatment
- No vomiting or diarrhea for 24


